Definition: Other health impairment means having limited strength, vitality, or alertness including a heightened alertness to environmental stimuli, that results in limited alertness with respect to the educational environment that is, chronic or acute health problems, such as asthma, attention deficit or attention deficit hyperactivity disorder, epilepsy, heart condition, hemophilia, lead poisoning, leukemia, nephritis, rheumatic fever, sickle cell anemia, or Tourette's syndrome and adversely affects a child's educational performance.

Checklist for Determining Eligibility:

1. Identification of Disability

Medical evidence of a chronic or acute health impairment; explain diagnosis

Documentation of limited strength, vitality, or alertness

Documentation, when possible, of a decline in strength, vitality, or alertness after the onset of the health impairment

2. Documentation of adverse effect on educational performance

3. Determination of need for special education and related services
